		Refuge (Neltner Hut) at 10,500ft

Mon July 7	Refuge – Toubkal	Early in the morning we make our attempt	

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	summit – Imlil	on the summit of Jebel Toukbal 13,671	
		ft/4,167m, the highest peak in Northern	
		Africa. Our route takes us up the south	
		cirque, crossing the stream above the	
		refuge. The walking is relatively	
		straightforward, but the scree and the	
		altitude will make the going quite difficult	
		in parts. From the summit you'll have	
		wonderful views over the Atlas Range and	
		the Sahara Desert. We will retrace our	
		steps down the mountain to the Toubkal	
		Refuge where we will have lunch and	
		continue our descent for another 4 hours to	
		the town of Imlil, 5800 ft/1780m.	
		Approx. 10 hrs, 16 mi/26 km.	
		Elevation gain: 2,952 ft/900m	
		Elevation loss: 7875 ft/2400m	Overnight guesthouse Imlil
