Thur Oct 30	Drive to Madaba, to visit the Greek Orthodox St. George Church and its amazing 6 th century A.D Holy Land Map made out of mosaics, then head to Mount Nebo where Moses and his people stood and viewed the Promised Land thousands of years ago, after that drive to the Dead Sea for floating and swimming, lunch, and then transfer to the Dana area for dinner and overnight. Fri Oct 31	After breakfast do a short hike in the old village of Dana and explore its old style of building houses dated back to the 19 th century A.D and then with our trekking guide start 5 - 6 hours trekking from the village all the way via the valley to Feynan. Feynan is one of the important settlements during the cooper age in Jordan. Dinner and overnight at the Feynan Eco lodge, voted one of the 50 best ecolodges in the world by National Geographic. Distance: 14-16 km, 5-6 hrs	Feynan Eco Lodge
Sat Nov 1	Transfer 2-3 hrs by 4x4 vehicle to Little Petra, via Wadi Araba desert and Namalah up to reach Shkaret Msei'd. Start trekking towards Beidah and Little Petra. Dinner and camping. Distance:17-22 km, 5-6 hrs	Seven Wonders Campsite
Sun Nov 2	Transfer by 4x4 vehicle 30 min to get closer to Mueisreh. Start trekking towards the Monastery in Petra and then via the city of Petra towards Snake Monument for dinner and camping (mobile camp inside Petra). This is the back entrance into Petra that only trekkers come in through. Distance: 14-18 km, 5-6 hrs	Snake Monument Campsite
Mon Nov 3	From the campsite in Petra beginning trekking to the main city to discover the main trail and attractions of the city: the Theatre, the Colonnaded Street, the Treasury and then back from the Siq, with options of visiting the High Place of Sacrifice with Wadi Farasa. Exit the main gate of Petra where most people enter. Dinner and overnight at a hotel in Wadi Mousa. Distance: 11-15 km, 4-6 hrs	Hotel in Petra
Tues Nov 4	Transfer by bus about 1.5 hours to Wadi Rum and start trekking to some of the best landscapes of the North part of Wadi Rum (AL- Kharazah). Trek for around 6-7 hours to reach Abu Al- Houl and the rocky bridges in Kharazah. Distance:16-19 km, 6-7 hrs	Fixed campsite at Wadi Rum
Wed Nov 5	Trek from the rocky bridges in Kharazah towards a nice area with the best view of the desert. Ride camels in the desert for a couple of hours before returning to the visitor center of Wadi Rum and transfering back to Amman. Distance: 5-7 km, 3 hrs trekking, 2 hrs camel trek Celebration dinner back in Amman	Hotel in Amman
